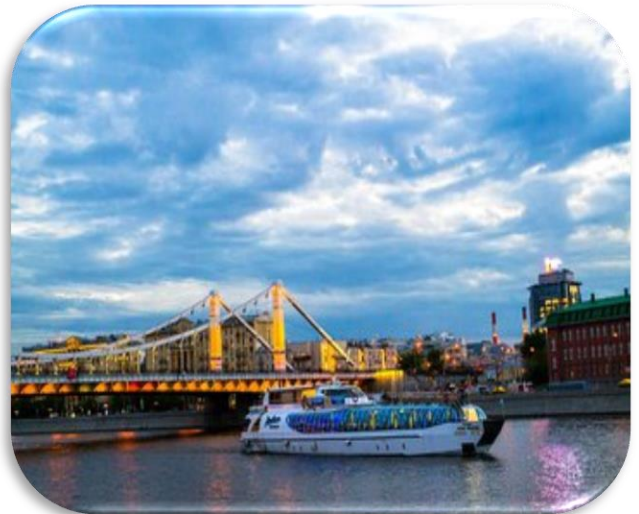
- ✓ Visit the Kremlin

The Moscow Kremlin – former residence of the Russian

tsars – is an architectural ensemble of unique beauty that took shape between the 15th and 20th centuries. At present the Kremlin includes six museums: the Armoury, 5 Cathedrals, one of them - Assumption Cathedral – being the main church of Russia. The famous Tsar Cannon of the 16th century and Tsar Bell of the 18th century are located on the Kremlin grounds too.

- ✓ Visit Trinity Lavra of St. Sergius

The Trinity Lavra of St. Sergius is a unique monastery complex and the spiritual center of Russian Orthodox Christianity.

- ✓ Tretyakov gallery is the world's biggest museum of Russian fine arts.
- ✓ Metro tour + Arbat Street  
Ride the Moscow Metro to see the spectacular statues, mosaics, marble floors and artwork of the stations. Then explore the Old Arbat, one of the oldest streets in Moscow, where craftsmen have practiced their crafts since the 15th century.
- ✓ Return to the hotel
